TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' COMPENSATION ORDINANCE NUMBER 2025-62

WHEREAS, The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania adopted Act of October 2, 2024, P.L., No. 94 amending the Act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No. 69) entitled "An Act concerning townships of the second class, and amending, revising, consolidating and changing the law relating thereto, in township supervisors, further providing for compensation of supervisors and;

WHEREAS, The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania amended Section 606(a) of the Act of May 1, 1933 (P.L. 103, No. 69), known as The Second-Class Township Code by adding subsections to read:

Section 606. Compensation of Supervisors, (a) Supervisors may receive as compensation and amount established by Ordinance not in excess of the following:

Township Population	Annual Maximum Compensation Old	Annual Maximum Compensation New
5,000 to 9,999	\$2,500.00	\$4,190.00
10,000 to 14,999	\$3,250.00	\$5,450.00
15,000 to 24,999	\$4,125.00	\$6,915.00
25,000 to 34,999	\$4,375.00	\$7,335.00
35,000 or more	\$5,000.00	\$8,385.00

Salaries are payable monthly or quarterly for the duties imposed by this act. The population is determined by the latest official census figures, except that no township official shall be required to reduce the salary of a supervisor as a result of a decrease in population. The compensation of supervisors, when employed as roadmasters, laborers, secretary, treasurer, assistant secretary, assistant treasurer or in any employee capacity not otherwise prohibited by this or any other act, shall be determined by the Board of Auditors, at an hourly, daily, weekly, semi-monthly or monthly basis, which shall be comparable to compensation paid in the locality for similar services. The Board of Supervisors may establish a mileage allowance, under the act of July 20, 1979 (P.L. 156, No. 51), referred to as the Uniform Mileage Fee Law, to be paid to officers and employees for the use of personal vehicles when required and actually used for Township business.

No supervisor may receive compensation as an employee for attending a meeting of the board of supervisors. Supervisors may continue to be compensated under prior law until such time as an ordinance is enacted under this act. Any changes in salary, compensation or emoluments of the elected office becomes effective at the beginning of the next term of the supervisor. A decision by the township to pay, in whole or part, to include supervisors not employed by the township in insurance plans, as authorized in subsection (c), supervisors until the beginning of the next term of that supervisor.

- (a.1) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the board of supervisors may provide that a supervisor may receive compensation on a per-meeting based on attendance of amounts specified in subsection (a). Compensation shall only be payable for duly advertised public meetings in which a supervisor participated, except compensation is not payable if a supervisor is absent from a meeting and the absence is not excused. Excused absence from a meeting shall be determined by the board of supervisors and shall include, but not limited to, an emergency or illness of a supervisor or the supervisor's immediate family as well as family or business travel. The board of supervisors may require documentation to support an excused absence.
- (a.2) If the board of supervisors determines that a supervisor shall receive compensation on a per-meeting basis under subsection (a.1), the determination must be made by ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Paupack Township, Wayne County Board of Supervisors reviewed and understand the compensation options made available through the adoption of Act of October 2, 2024, P.L. 974, No. 94 titled Second-Class Township Code – Compensation of Supervisors and;

WHEREAS, the Paupack Township, Wayne County Board of Supervisors will be compensating supervisors on a monthly basis (\$262.08) at an annual compensation rate (\$3,145.00) as established in Section 606 of Act of October 2, 2024, P.L. 974, No.94 titled Second-Class Township Code – Compensation of Supervisors and;

WHEREAS, the increase in compensation for a supervisor in Paupack Township, Wayne County becomes effective at the beginning of the next term of the supervisor based on Act of October 2, 2024, P.L. 974, No. 94 titled Second-Class Code Compensation of Supervisors and the adoption of this Paupack Township, Wayne County Ordinance Number 2025-62 titled Township Supervisors' Compensation and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Paupack Township, Wayne County Board of Supervisors at their regularly monthly meeting conducted on Thursday, September 11, 2025 adopted the Paupack Township, Wayne County Ordinance Number 2025-62 titled Township Supervisors' Compensation by a vote of 3 yes and 0 no.

This Ordinance shall be effective on September 11, 2025.
